English

Maths

The children will build on their Year 5 learning and cover areas such as place value to 10,000,000, fractions and decimals, algebra, geometry and data. It is important that they know their times tables and number bonds.

Term 1 – Our topic is Hola Mexico!

The focus is the Maya Civilisation. The children will be developing their geographical and historical knowledge of this ancient civilisation.

Science – Animals Including Humans (heart, lungs, blood)

During this topic the children will plan enquiries, collect and record data and interpret results.
